Who would benefit?

Ideal candidates are students who demonstrate:

- Positive behaviour during the school year
- A willingness and eagerness to learn
- The potential to achieve Level 1 and/or Level 2
- Regular attendance and consistent punctuality during school year
- A need for further work on Language and Mathematics skills and learning skills instruction
- A need to build confidence in themselves as learners who can be successful
- A willingness to work collaboratively with their peers

Timelines and Registration Process

- Parent Information Brochures, the SCORE application and Camp I Can Brochure are sent to home schools during the **first week of May**
- By **May 14th** - Grade 7 & 8 potential candidates identified for both programs
- By **May 18th** - all applications due back at home school for both programs
- By **May 21st** - all complete registration forms, plus attached reports/IEPs due at Continuing Education for processing
- **Late June**, confirmation letters and transportation information sent to home schools for selected students
