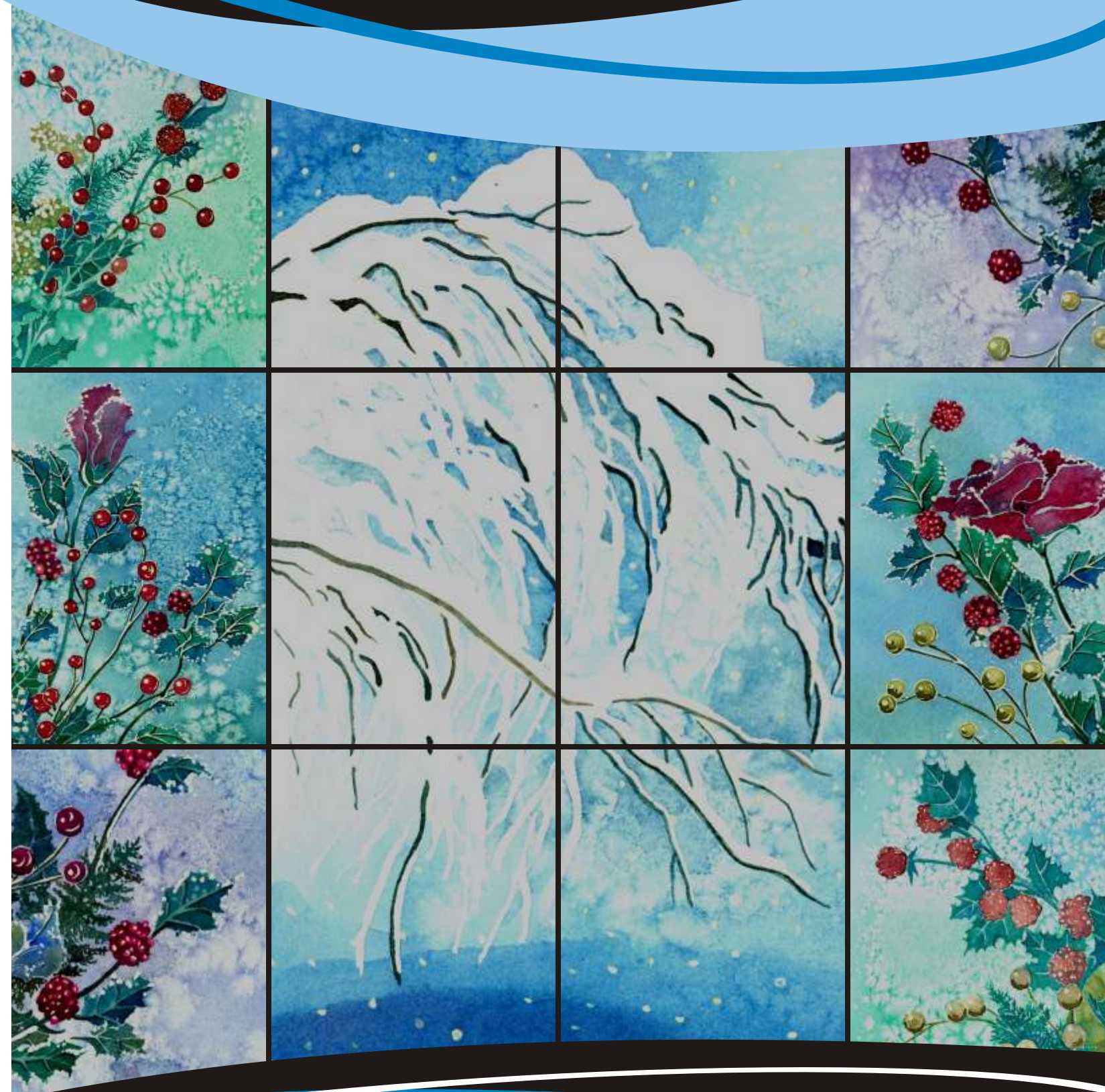
Cancellation of Courses
