- ❶ Broadcasting and Video Production: This single credit interdisciplinary course will provide students with opportunities to develop knowledge and skills related to the creative and technical aspects of television broadcasting and live to tape video production. Students will learn to safely and effectively use appropriate software and equipment such as video cameras, lighting and audio systems, switchers, editing suites etc. Emphasis will be placed on the development of interpersonal skills and working in a team to meet communication and production requirements. (Prerequisites: AVI 200 visual arts and TGJ 200 tech communications)
